

SUBJECT: Instructions For Adding EMS Compact Privilege to Practice Providers (PTP) to Agency PTP Rosters

I am pleased to announce that Pennsylvania continues to make progress with implementation of the EMS Compact, which was signed into law here in 2022. The EMS Compact standardizes the licensure requirements for EMS personnel and provides immediate Privilege to Practice (PTP) for any EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic to work within another EMS Compact state under their home state's license/certification. The Pennsylvania EMS Registry has been updated so EMS agency managers can utilize these eligible providers without completing the certification by endorsement process. Any agency utilizing out of state EMS Compact providers must add the PTP provider to their roster as described below.


For the purposes of safety or spot inspections regional EMS council staff will verify a PTP provider's status via their home state's certification and your agency's PTP roster in the EMS Registry. The EMS agency medical director is responsible for credentialing a PTP provider via the same process as they credential the agency's other EMS personnel, specifically at the ALS level.

Adding privilege to practice (PTP) providers to roster

Agencies wishing to utilize out of state providers who have PTP in accordance with the EMS Compact must add the providers to their agency's PTP roster by following the steps below.


- 1- Once logged into to your agency's registry account, click on the "EMS Agency" tab and then the "PTP" tab.

2- Enter the provider's EMSID. (Instructions to search for PTP providers below)

- Enter the provider's EMSID in the EMSID box and click submit. If the provider is already in the registry, they will instantly appear on your PTP roster.



Add Existing Provider by EMSID

EMS ID:

- If the provider does not appear on your roster, you will need to add them to the registry.
 - Enter the provider's information
 - Verify they have privilege to practice at [Quick Verify EMS Status | EMS Compact \(https://www.emscompact.gov/employers/verify-my-status\)](https://www.emscompact.gov/employers/verify-my-status) and upload a copy of their PTP verification.
 - Complete and acknowledge completion of tasks by checking the four check boxes.
 - Click submit. The provider will be added to your agency's PTP roster.

You can view and make changes to your agency's PTP roster at any time on your agency's PTP tab.

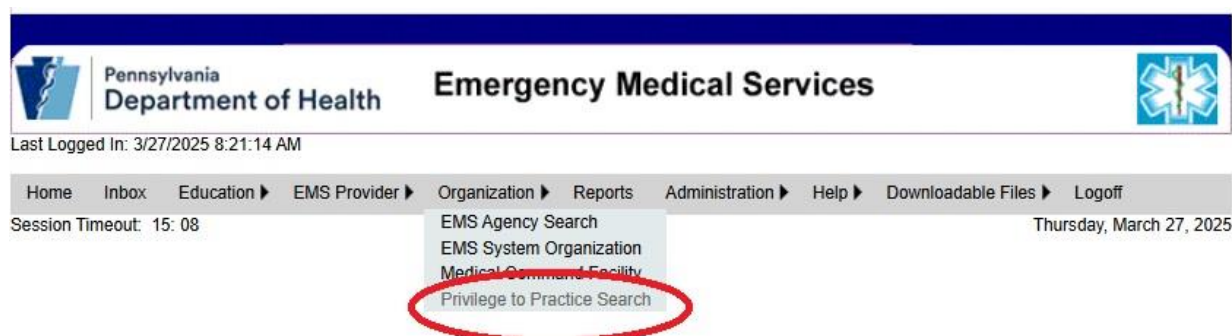
- To view a PTP provider's information, click on select.

- PTP providers whose home state certification has expired will appear in red. PTP status should be verified and expiration date updated for all PTP providers with an expired home state certification.

Searching for PTP providers

- In the Organization drop down at the top of the page, select "Privilege to Practice Search."



- You can search by entering information into any of the fields or leave them blank to see a list of all PTP providers in the registry.

***Please note:**

PTP is only for EMT, AEMT, and Paramedic certifications. In order to operate a licensed EMS vehicle, the provider MUST have a Pennsylvania Emergency Medical Services Vehicle Operator (EMSVO) certification.

The PTP number is used the same as a state credential number for documentation and data integration purposes.
